

# DDE DYNAMIC DIVE EXHIBITION GENERAL REGULATION

## APPROACH TO DDE GENERAL REGULATION

*as DDE is a completely different from traditional fair, general regulation is sometime drafted in an explanatory mode, what means that it has embedded notes, explanations, reflections, attentions, invitations and suggestions which are topic connected (when different from traditional).*

*Its goal is to communicate the sense of regulation choices and several implementing possibilities to get a better "Dynamic Fair Instrument" understanding, what will let participant get its optimum benefits*



### A) PARTICIPATION BOND

- 1 DDE participation is bound to acceptance of all rules expressed by DDE unique official news agency
- 2 DDE unique official news agency is [www.ddexhibition.org](http://www.ddexhibition.org) website
- 3 Regulation can be updated-expanded in any moment. The only authentic is last published version. Not updated downloads are invalidated, the same for PDF and extracts sent for information purposes by DDE if passed by new rules
- 4 Some specialties or specific operations regulations, and documentation forms are embedded in related sections
- 5 It's participant's responsibility refer to that website, in its entirety for any needed information, and be sure he is using last version

### B) DENOMINATIONS

- 1 Fair is named DDE, Dynamic Dive Exhibition, [www.ddexhibition.org](http://www.ddexhibition.org)
- 2 It is organised DESA, Dive Expedition Support Agency, [www.desa.ws](http://www.desa.ws)

### C) ADMITTED EXIBITORS

- 1 Any structure that, in any way, performs scuba diving directly or indirectly related activities may be accepted

### D) PRIORITY ADMITTED AND MOST ADVANTAGED SUBJECTS

- 1 Public, public research institutions, Navy, Army, any military and public body, Category associations have free of charge admittance

- 2 Activities related to "on field organization" will be greatly emphasized and given real high priority
- 3 Special conventions and / or filed equipment will be offered to most limit live costs (food, accomodation, and so on)

### E) OTHER KIND OF ADMITTANCE

- 1 Different kind of no exhibitors admittance are allowed, what means in and out water operaztions (in example demonstrations, common useful updating, stages, and so on) communication operaztions (in example meetings, conferences, video projections, and so on); refer to DDE website

### F) ADMITTED PRODUCTS AND SERVICES

- 1 Any product or service directly or indirectly scuba diving related may be accepted
- 2 Any non scuba diving related product or service cannot be accepeted, if there is no written application for admission followed by DDE written acceptance
- 3 Non exhibitor related material, as, in example, other structure's depliants is not allowed (uless officially declared as "guest trademark", read "Participation Application Form"). Violation of this rule will lead to a 250 euro fine, bigger damage will result in greater compensation

### G) PARTICIPATION APPLICATION

- 1 1) can be done through application form filling and answering to any contained question (refer to DDE website)

### H) ACCEPTANCE OF PARTICIPATIONE TO SOLE OWNED SURFACE

- 1 Participation acceptance will be valid only if written
- 2 Unaccepted participation will also be given in writing. DDE is not obliged to make its decision's reasons known
- 3 Under any circumstances exhibitor will not be allowed to, totally or partially, give or exchange his assigned surface or stand

## I) DEPOSIT

- 1 in any case deposit will be given back, unless application will be unaccepted by DDE
- 2 Balance of payment must arrive by agreed terms (see "Participation Application Form")
- 3 In absence of balance by agreed terms DDE will consider contract terminated, by fault of requesting party, without any need for formal or judicial case
- 4 In absence of balance by agreed terms DDE will be allowed to use of any space and resource previously assigned to defaulting applicant
- 5 Unpaid balance will lead defaulting applicant to pay double of balance fine as a penalty, bigger damage will result in greater compensation

## L) EXIBITOR SURRENDER

- 1 Can be requested only within 90 days from fair starting date, beyond this date it will not be considered valid
- 2 Must be asked to DDE in writing
- 3 Must be accompanied by attached reason detailed

## N) ASSIGNMENTS

- 1 DDE will assign products (in example water & underwater structures and so on) and services (in example surface, parking, surface and underwater assistance and so on) trying to meet maximum participant's satisfaction (what means trying to follow his indications) but always in its own discretion (what means that participant's indications will not be considered as binding)
- 2 DDE will have the right to move to other position or modify (what means reducing it) without any chance of asking for reparation or compensation by participant for alleged damage
- 3 DDE will be allowed to assign exhibition areas notwithstanding or in addition to their official map

## O) SETTING

### □ Self setting

- 1 Participant is allowed to set acquired area, or part of it, using his own equipment
- 2 This kind of setting must be known and authorized by DDE
- 3 Requested information, including, with other, law certificates and designs must be provided to DDE
- 4 Being requested a DDE intervention to evaluate what has been proposed, to certify and authorize it, and for other services (in example electrical panel positioning, electricity drafting and so on) DDE work will be paid (for details refer to "Participation Application" on DDE website)

### □ preformatted

- 5 DDE offers some standard solutions, simple and economic. Refer to DDE website for information

### □ settled by external company

- 6 to set a customized setting DDE convention and authorized company is OPRA. Refer to DDE

documentation

- 4 It will never give right to ask paid money in return
- 5 May be that it will not give right not to pay remaining balance, if DDE, at its own discretion, will not recognize that surrender is due to force reason, participant will be considered defaulting and will be treated as explained in chapter I-3 and I-5, space and resources will be used as explained in chapter I-4

## M) DDE ORGANIZATION WITHDRAW

- 1 DDE will be allowed to withdraw from the contract
- 2 It can be done within 155 days from fair starting date with no justification need
- 3 It can be done within 5 days from fair starting date for security reason or, generally, for fair smooth functioning. Those reasons have to be officially explained by writing to participant
- 4 DDE will give all paid money back to exhibitor
- 5 Exhibitor will not have any right to ask for reparation or compensation for alleged damage

website for information

- 7 Any economic, and possible legal, relationship will take place between participant and external company

## P) COMMON AREAS USE AND PERIMETER MARKING

- 1 for public and security reason and to afford comfortable passage and regular conduct of everybody's business it is not allowed encumbrance and use, neither minimum nor temporary, of areas external to stand (what means common areas) for any use
- 2 If exhibitor wants to operate on the lawn or beach close to his stand, he can acquire those areas within his contract
- 3 After registration he will have to highlight external acquired area (by design) to DDE, this area can stay unsettled, nude area but has to be perimeter marked by structures to separate it from common external areas (for detailed INFORMATION refer to "Participation Application" on DDE website)

## Q) WRONG STAND POSITIONING

- 1 in case of wrong positioning of exhibitor's (or any other admitted presence's) structure, positioning totally or partially different from assigned one, DDE will have the right to move all what is necessary to correct destination
- 2 Exhibitor, or any other admitted presence, will be charged for work done by DDE, minimum charge amount is 1000 euro, plus any damage caused by his error

## R) OWN VESSELS

- 1 put own vessel in water is allowed. It is free of charge

- 2 Such a procedure has to be known and authorized by DDE
- 3 Requested information, including, and not only, law certificates to navigate Lago Maggiore, have to be provided to DDE
- 4 Vessel and its crew must conform to DDE requested features under exhibitor's desired use (described in application)
- 5 Vessel and its crew must move within water field following DDE established instructions and procedures (separate special form)
- 6 Any vessel with or without crew, when in pause, can be made available to organization as a possible help to smooth operation of fair water activities
- 7 Any vessel must immediately stop any activity (if this would not cause risks to its operations) when asked by organization to manage serious emergencies or prevent serious safety problems. That means that vessel, with its crew, will be available to DDE organization responsible for safety and rescue, and will follow with no delay their orders. This request may be made orally "on field". Any request refusal, delay or violation to authority orders will result in a complaint for failed assistance

*Explanatory note : any boat and vessel is moving in a wide but potentially crowded area. There will be, according to water field provisions, guidelines to move and behave. In short vessel is moving within a regulated system and not doing a tour. We have also to say that, at the outbreak of a possible emergency, any possibly useful resource must immediately be made available. Finally we think it is balanced that, having the free of charge chance to place in water, for his own purposes, his own water resources when those ones are not used, may, if needed, actively participate in surface operations, in a wide cross collaboration atmosphere whose goal is the fair best success*

## **S) SETTING UP MACHINERY, ACCIDENT PREVENTION**

Setting up machinery is allowed:

- 1 Only after detailed written request and related acceptance by DDE
- 2 Under exhibitor's direct and sole responsibility
- 3 Provided they do not create disturbances, harassments, any kind of problem
- 4 Provided they comply with the law related to that operation in a fair environment, especially accident prevention rules, and exhibitor has competent authorities' permission, and everything is legal and within public security regulation
- 5 Provided that higher power consumption will be repaid to organization through a prior assessment, prepayment of evaluated amount, and final effective balance
- 6 DDE keeps the right, in its own discretion and in any moment, to end any exhibitor's machinery setting up

## **T) STRUCTURES IN USE, RESPONSIBILITY AND DAMAGE BY PARTICIPANTS**

- 1 Here and in any regulation and DDE website part, anybody, in any way interacting with fair, is defined "participant"
- 2 Participant is responsible of any possible damage caused to area allocated and granted in use structures
- 3 Participant is responsible of any possible damage caused by him or by his organization (what means any member or any work management activity) to the environment (in example
- 4 Il partecipante, se espositore, è altresì demandato alla costante pulizia, così come (al disallestimento) della rimessa in ordine come la ha inizialmente trovata, della sua area espositiva
- 5 Il partecipante come penale di danneggiamenti od incurie dovrà corrispondere a DDE l'importo di 500 €, salvo il diritto al maggiore risarcimento in caso di maggior danno
- 6 Il partecipante, se espositore, è demandato alla regolarizzazione, tramite corresponsione dei canoni SIAE, delle strutture audio-visive

## **U) PROTESTS, COMPLAINTS, OTHERS**

- 1 Organization responsible body (DDE) is also responsible for collecting any possible complaint, against organization itself but against any fair participant too (what means diver-visitors too)
- 2 Complaints, declarations, safety and danger notices, dangerous behaviour notices must be given by writing (even quickly, two hand written lines in front of DDE deputy)
- 3 Anonymous and oral complaints, if not accompanied by written notes, will be ignored
- 4 When intervention by Police is not needed, DDE will verify what has been highlighted, then, at its own discretion, will take any right felt decision

## **V) ACTIVITIES TERMINATION**

- 1 DDE will keep the right to close exhibitor's exhibition area for regulation violation, lack of safety, and for any other caused problem or in presence of a probable problem cause (preventive approach to be mostly used for water safety reason)
- 2 Same rights will be exercised against other admitted presences (as described in chapter "E")
- 3 This measure can be delivered in the presence of a Notary or Public Officer, at anytime within fair
- 4 Under this measure exhibitor and/or any other admitted subject will have to immediately close his structure so terminating any internal and external activity
- 5 Structure cannot be disassembled if not when allowed by organization
- 6 Exhibitor, or any other admitted presence, will pay to DDE a 1000 euro fine, plus any amount due to damage caused by his behaviour

## **Z) FAIR HEADQUARTER**

- 1 Location is MACCAGNO province of VARESE
- 2 Fair area is located in PARCO GIONA and wide water area in front of it
- 3 Any other information is on DDE website

## **AA) STRUCTURE ASSEMBLING**

- 1 Thursday 8 May 2008 from 09.00 am to 08.00 pm

## **BB) DISASSEMBLING**

- 1 Monday 12 May 2008 from 09.00 am to 08.00 pm
- 2 For each late day, or part of it, Exhibitor, or any other admitted presence, will pay to DDE a 1000 euro fine, plus any amount due to damage caused by his behaviour

## **CC) FAIR**

- 1 Friday, Saturday, Sunday 9-10-11 May 2008-02-08

## **DD) TIMETABLES**

- 1 Terrestrial field : from 09.00 am to 08.00 pm

*Explanatory note: exhibitor may keep its stand open through all this time interval. He can so give assistance to visitors after dinner too, far extending contact activity, in traditional fairs this terminate normally at 5-6 pm. We suggest such activity, taking advantage that social activities will be organized, to make the staying inside fair area nice to visitor*

*Explanatory note 2 : activities stop time, included play ones, from 00.00 am to 09.00 am, must be strictly adhered, as fair area must be quiet to let everybody (visitor, staff member, scientific researcher, in short any person who stays overnight on field) have an healthful rest*

- 2 Water field : from 10.00 am to 05.00 pm

*Explanatory note: we have to terminate activities at 05.00 pm to make tank filling operation be possible, there will be many empty tanks and will ask a long time to be filled, and we cannot do this night time for the reasons described above. We should say that 7 hours a day in water are a lot of time, participans can organize himself to manage them in the best way*

- 3 Water field available from 07.00 pm to 08.00 pm upon detailed written request and written DDE acceptance

*Explanatory note: it is possible to use water field also in "night diving mode" to let people try those kind of equipment that can be better appreciated with no light. We must remember that we need surface assistance and medical safety service alert. This is why this service must be prviously requested in the program and accepted by DDE*

## **EE) ACCESS TO WATER FIELD**

Nobody is allowed to access water field if not provided with pass issued for :

- 1 Is part, in any position, of DDE or is directly authorized by DDE
- 2 Is an exhibitor or other kind of admitted presence, or their teamer
- 3 Is directly autorized by exhibitor or other kind

of admitted presence

## **FF) WATER PASS VALIDITY**

- 1 above categories EE-1 and EE-2 have DDE issued pass valid for all fair duration
- 2 category EE-3 has a pass issued by exhibitor and valid once, allows only one water access

## **GG) WATER FIELD USAGE**

- 1 EE-1 category's pass specify services performed for DDE (assistance, control, safety, rescue, and so on)
- 2 EE-2 category's pass aims to accompany customers and/or visitors inerested in proposed activity / experience
- 3 EE-3 category's pass aims to have an authorized dive with test or experience purpose

*Explanatory note: DDE cannot be an open to everybody, willing a "tour dive", diving field, that is not within fair purpose and, most of all, would cause the system collapse and rise serious safety problems*

## **HH) ISSUE OF WATER PASS – FORMS- PROPERTY**

- 1 to obtain or issue any pass, is necessary fill all DDE provided forms and standards to be able to perform this operation, any other mode is not accepted
- 2 any pass not provided by DDE cannot be issued
- 3 Forms and pass are free of charge and must be free of charge also for vsitors
- 4 Forms and pass are DDE property, it licences exhibitor and any other admitted presence to use them, so DDE can withdraw them if and when, at its own discretion, would think it right

## **II) WATER PASS ISSUE LIMITS**

- 1 dive pass different from visitor's skill certification level cannot be issued
- 2 may be issued demonstration or discover pass (in example "discover scuba" or "discover nitrox"9 or experience pass (i.e. Trimix Experience or Rebreather Experience)
- 3 Any pass to follow corses or make "tour dives", what means incompatible with DDE philosophical line and purposes, cannot be issued

## **LL) CHECK IN AT WATER ENTRANCE, REFUSAL, PASS SUSPENSION AND WITHDRAW**

- 1 DDE makes Checks at water entrance (and at any possible time during fair)
- 2 In case of difference between pass and diver certification level found or in case of any violation of behaviour rules above explained, DDE will reject water entrance request, withdraw diver pass, suspend for indefinite period exhibitor's pass issuing ability, and finally confiscate all related forms
- 3 DDE will also reject any water entrance request by drunk, sick, harassing or indisciplinate people as they can be considered, at its own discretion, dangerous for themselves and/or

- other people, and however undesirable
- 4 In case of doubt DDE will be allowed to ask for a medical check (to be quickly done on the spot) in the absence of this DDE will refuse water entrance

#### MM) INFORMATION REQUEST DURING FAIR

- 1 Any fair participant, at anytime, must provide all information asked him by DDE
- 2 Partial or total refusal may cause DDE interdiction or termination of activities linked to asked information

*Explanatory note: this mainly refers to water – underwater activities even if any other area may be included*

#### NN) TRADITIONAL WATER PROGRAMS EXECUTION

- 1 “Discover”, “Experience” and similar program execution must be managed following rules and limits accepted by educational associations under whose auspices they are proposed
- 2 “Discover”, “Experience” and similar programs execution must be managed only by someone enabled by those associations and insurance policy
- 3 Accompanying visitor in a dive equal to or lower than his certified level is not mandatory
- 4 When visitor is accompanied, accompanist must be qualified and insurance provided for that specific level of diving practice
- 5 Traditional water programs execution does not require any declaration or request to DDE, as they are already included in DDE fair modality

the event of major damage, and will denounce violation responsible if this involves criminal implications

#### PP) SPECIAL WATER PROGRAM” DEFINITION

- 1 Are considered “special” : Record Attempt, Special Tests, Competitions, Different Content Demonstration, and so on, .... more generally any scenario out of a normal interpretation of a diving, divers club, diving school daily management
- 2 For the same above point of view (daily management of diving, ad so on) also “traditional programs” can be considered “special programs” if performed in a mode or number different from fisiologic limit (in example a group of 100 “Nitrox Discover” who dive all together, even if represents a real normal teaching program, number of participants asks for a “special” assistance, delimited event area and so on)

#### OO) SPECIAL WATER PROGRAMS EXECUTION

*Explanatory note: execution of special water programs is not only possible but desirable decidedly, DDE impels exhibitor to organize extra, interesting, stimulating, creative, customized programs that allow to exploit great possibilities given by DDE provided logistical structure*

- 1 Special programs must be official, defined and studied together with organization, to optimize DDE logistical support, and possibly build a customized logistical support (DDE is open and available to do this) Refer to DDE website for “special program proposal form”
- 2 DDE will not accept special programs considered against fair policy, or cannot guarantee them sufficient support, or cannot be covered by insurance, or location is considered unsuitable or any other discretionary reason
- 3 Non authorized special water program cannot be performed
- 4 If somebody will execute or try to execute unauthorized programs, DDE will inform the police and will prevent in any way their continuation or implementation
- 5 Upon implementation or trying to implement special unauthorized programs DDE will ask responsible participant for a fine of 10.000 euro, except the right to greater compensation in

#### QQ) INSURANCE

- 1 Professional diver (up from Divemaster or equivalent, exhibitor, agonistic competitor, participant to any initiative, and so on) guarantees to be insurance provided for the activity he will perform
- 2 DDE is not responsible for assumptions damage that professional will suffer from others, or will cause to others or in itself
- 3 Non professional diver is not asked for insurance (although it is strongly recommended, as always, out of fair and during normal diving activity)
- 4 DDE is not responsible for assumptions damage that diver will suffer from others, or will cause to others or in itself
- 5 Exhibitor or any other admitted presence guarantees to be provided with a valid, against “all risk”, insurance for the fair, that covers any material brought to the fair, civil responsibility towards others, and renunciation of revenge against DDE and DESA. DDE can offer such and insurance to whom do not have it (refer to DDE website)
- 6 DDE is not responsible for assumptions damage that exhibitor or any other admitted presence (generally any “participant”) will suffer from others, or will cause to others or in itself

## RR) VISITOR DUTIES

- 1 to access to water he must sign the standard form he will find at any exhibitor or any other admitted presence, then he has to show his diving certification (it will ask only 30 seconds) and, only in event of doubt, answer to possible further questions also about his physical conditions (about this we may seek for "on field" located medical and ask for spirometer analysis)
- 2 Visitor is committed to perfectly following the declared purposes of his dive program (in example -3 mt to test a mask or -100 mt to test a regulator)
- 3 Visitor may be anytime checked, also when coming out of water or after that
- 4 DDE will prevent any further water entry to harassing and/or undisciplined (and/or, in its own discretion, dangerous to themselves or other) subjects

*Explanatory note: this part of regulation (and any part referred to water activities) may seem not sympathetic and overly dirigistica but must be placed in relation with the scenario in which will be implemented. DDE will have around 100.000 square meters of water surface, with several buoys, also at very important depth and for complex dive systems, with an extremely structured service machine, this with rigid action and answer standards. Number of divers simultaneously in water will be the largest ever had before in any part of the world, and with simultaneous very different mode. DDE will also allow the proper conduct of several scientific research programs, that depend on the use of some logistic structures within established, very narrow times. Then general contest must be well regulated, that will directly benefit safety and service efficiency toward visitor. Visitor who is being offered, free of charge, operative possibilities never even thought before now, visitor who is only asked to follow dive rules together with willingness to give precise assurances and prove that. In short visitor is asked for the same seriousness with which DDE deals with its own tasks*

## SS) VISITOR RESPONSIBILITY

- 1 Visitor, in accompanied programs too, is totally responsible for his own dive, both towards

himself and other possibly involved divers and towards possibly used equipment

## TT) EXHIBITOR AND ANY OTHER ADMITTED PRESENCE RESPONSIBILITY

- 1 Exhibitor, and any other admitted presence is responsible for his own traditional and special initiatives, for his structure general administration, in short, using an "all included" expression, for the proper "functioning" of his entire operative machine
- 2 That must be done both following this regulation (explained here and in DDE website) and (when possibly missing parts of regulation) following attention and common sense of a "good family father"

## UU) DDE ORGANIZATION RESPONSIBILITY

- 1 DDE disclaims any liability for both supplier and third parties provided works
- 2 DDE assumes no liability and do not guarantee on any water, power and telephone supply, it merely transmit supply companies performances
- 3 Organization disclaims any liability resulting to any subject from DDE participant attributable facts, also, and not only, with regard to specific and general fair regulation
- 4 DDE, granting free activities ("traditional" ad described in chapter "NN") and accepting special activities (see chapter "OO") is obviously far from "implicitly certify" that those are without risks, and, in no way assumes any co-liability (also if partial) for them. **DDE acceptance of activities must be interpreted only as willingness to make existing structures available or built customized ones to satisfy participant needs, and nothing else**
- 5 Responsibility for all activities, and more for special ones, are everytime attributable to author/promoter/holder/organizer/participant of related activities
- 6 The basic principle is that DDE makes a logistic structure available. It's use and knowledge depend on individuals and single participating and using ent criteria

## VV) ALCOHOL TEST

- 1 DDE will monitor alcohol consumption
- 2 Who will refuse to undergo this test will be excluded from diving for 24 hours and/or until next control

*Explanatory note: there is no reason to forbid alcohol in the fair (who will not dive should be able to find it) and, in addition, this measure would have very dubious, or no effectiveness at all. But this matter is so important that DDE wish to talk about common sense "behavior rules". DDE strongly suggests that alcohol use, even if in minimal quantity, should be avoided during daytime and used in a moderate*

*amount during evening. It is understandable easy losing inhibitions when you feel good in a good company, in a comfortable and structured ( even for social events and evening parties) environment, but it is also important understanding that you have to be OK if you want to dive the day after. This is not just about visitors but all participants. Starting with DDE members, following with exhibitors and, in a chain, everybody else. We must understand that the day after there will be hard work to be done, several dives, several visitors to be accompanied, so we have to be really sober to perform not only normal stand work but a lot of water one. This*

*is also important for night rest, this fair is really different from any other fair, it is not objectively possible to be in parties until 6 in the morning if you are on duty for water work only few hours later*

#### **ZZ) USE OF DDE TRADEMARK**

- 1 After application acceptance participant will be allowed to free use DDE logo to represent his presence inside fair
- 2 Any other trademark use may be authorized after detailed request to DDE

#### **AAA) HOW TO COMMUN ICATE ALL PROGRAMS AND INTITIVES TO DDE**

- 1 Both if mandatory to get the performing permission and if implicit in DDE format, DDE suggests any initiative being communicated to organization, to get an "open to public" (website) official schedule, to get the maximum visitor attention, and let him better organize himself also interacting with initiative's owner (reservation, information, an so on)
- 2 Ater initiative communication, exhibitor or any other admitted presence must, as soon as possible, communicate any updates or changes

#### **BBB) MEDIA AND DDE PHOTO-VIDEO MATERIAL**

- 1 DDE will directly or indirectly acquire any kind of image of material and people participating to fair
- 2 DDE will be allowed to use those images for any purpose and operazion with no prio required permission
- 3 DDE is not liable for illegal reproduction of images obtained in fair

#### **CCC) EXHIBITOR'S ADVERTISING**

- 1 It is authorized only wihtin his own exhibition area, it is strongly forbidden out of it
- 2 In case of violation to this rule exhibitor must immediatly remove his outdoor advertising ant will pay, as a fine, an amount of maoney varying from 100 and 1000 euro, depending on the importance and employment of advertizing area improperly used

#### **DDD) OTHER ADVERTIZING**

- 1 No kind of other advertizing is allowed

- 2 DDE officially authorized ones are excluded from this ban, as those belong to partners, sponsors,, supporters and other kind of twinning/co-participation/collaboration with DDE
- 3 In case of violation to this rule exhibitor must immediatly remove his outdoor advertising ant will pay, as a fine, an amount of maoney varying from 100 and 1000 euro, depending on the importance and employment of advertizing area improperly used

#### **EEE) CATALOG - VARIOUS PUBLICATION - PERSONAL DATA MANAGEMENT**

- 2 DDE will not be liable for possible errors or omissions
- 3 Catalog offers avertizing spaces possibilities, refer to website for information
- 4 Catalog will be published and spread on media and ways deemed most appropriate by DDE
- 5 Other publications or promotions or other, that may contain part or all catalog information may be made by DDE, number and nature of then will be decided by DDE in its oen discretion

#### **FFF) SECURITY**

- 1 DDE provides a night security service during fair days, setting day, and day before unsetting
- 2 DDE will not be liable foor any theft, damage, or any problem could happen to exhibitor
- 3 Care of property is responsibility of sole property owner

#### **GGG) PARGAMERS EDITING**

- 1 DDE at anytime may change any fair parameter, like location, dates and timetables, in its own discretion and without any compensation or repayment to anybody

#### **HHH) LEGAL DOMICILE, JURISDICTION**

- 1 Participant will elect his legal domicile at the fair headquarters
- 2 He accept italian jurisdiction and Gallarate (VA) Court competence
